#### THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN SCHEDULING IF INTERESTED IN HONORS COURSES AND JAZZ BAND:

- \*FOREIGN LANGUAGE/HEALTH It is recommended that students interested in Jazz Band join marching band to exempt themselves of the PE requirement. In addition, students should also do one of the following: take their foreign language in 8th & 9th grade, take Health or a Foreign Language as an online course, or "test out" of their Health requirement.
- MARCHING BAND If a student takes Marching Band for three (3) years, the class will exempt/replace the one-semester physical education (PE) credit requirement.
- \*\*BAND IN 9th GRADE Those student that take one full year/credit of a band class (i.e. band in 9th grade), will fulfill their one-credit Visual, Preforming, and Applied Arts graduation requirement.
- PLEASE NOTE Students do not need to be in the Honors Academy to take AP and Honors courses. The extreme is represented above. Most students take a schedule that is similar, but slightly less demanding. This can also free up space in the schedule for Jazz Band.
